**On Amendment to Clause 3 of the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of
Ukraine No. 537 of 7 May 2022**

The Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine **resolves:**

To amend Clause 3 of the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine No. 537 “Some issues of state control to check compliance with the legislation on food, feed, animal by-products, health and welfare of animals, state veterinary and sanitary control and imports of goods to the customs territory of Ukraine during martial law” of 7 May 2022 (Official Visnyk of Ukraine, 2022, No. 40, Art. 2172), as attached.

AMENDMENT
to Clause 3 of the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine
No. 537 of 7 May 2022

Clause 3 shall be amended to read as follows:

“3. It shall be established that during the period of martial law, imports of goods into the customs territory of Ukraine is permitted taking into account the following specifics:

imports of consignments with products from countries subject to restrictions due to outbreaks of diseases on their territory included in the list of diseases approved by the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH), or other diseases that pose a threat to human and/or animal health, as defined by the legislation of Ukraine or international law, shall be permitted exclusively under the conditions specified in a relevant decision (order) of the Chief State Veterinary Inspector of Ukraine;

imports of consignments with productive animals and reproductive material derived from them, from establishments that have not been considered to be in compliance with the legislation of Ukraine, shall be permitted provided that such consignments are imported (sent) into the customs territory of Ukraine from countries whose establishments were considered compliant with the legislation of Ukraine within two years prior to the date of entry into force of this Resolution or during its validity, and taking into account the epizootic situation in the country of origin of the consignment;

imports of consignments with productive animals in case of their transit through the territory of third countries shall be permitted provided that the transit is carried out exclusively through territories officially recognized by the competent authority of the relevant country as free from particularly dangerous diseases included in the list of diseases approved by the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH) to which such animals are susceptible, provided that such consignments were not unloaded and/or reloaded in the territory of countries where the relevant diseases are registered.”.
