(Designated quarantine items)

Article 45

The designated quarantine items referred to in Article 37 paragraph 1 of the Act shall be the following:

(1) The following animals and their carcasses:

a. (omitted)

b. Chicken, quail, pheasant, [emu](#), ostrich, guinea fowl and turkey, and Anseriformes including duck, goose and other birds of Anseriformes (hereinafter referred to as “ducks”) (excluding one day-old chicks of these animals meeting the conditions prescribed by the Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries which are to be exported in status quo without being moved outside the area of the seaport or airport into which they were imported in compliance with the directions of the animal quarantine officer).
